```
/* Old password type */
SET PASSWORD FOR 'some_user'@'some_host' = OLD_PASSWORD('mypass');
/* New password type */
SET PASSWORD FOR 'some_user'@'some_host' = PASSWORD('mypass');

ALTER USER 'root'@'localhost' IDENTIFIED WITH mysql_native_password BY
'mypass';
```

'mysql_native_password' is deprecated and will be removed in a future release. Please use caching_sha2_password instead

SHOW VARIABLES LIKE 'validate_password%';
