

Installing Clam Antivirus on Ubuntu 14.04 Server

Here is how you can install ClamAV on Ubuntu 14.04 server:

```
root@server:~# apt-get install clamav clamav-daemon -y
root@server:~# freshclam
root@server:~# service clamav-freshclam start
root@server:~# service clamav-daemon start
```

Perform a test scan:

```
root@server:~# clamscan /home

----- SCAN SUMMARY -----
Known viruses: 3497984
Engine version: 0.98.1
Scanned directories: 1
Scanned files: 0
Infected files: 0
Data scanned: 0.00 MB
Data read: 0.00 MB (ratio 0.00:1)
Time: 9.583 sec (0 m 9 s)
```

Logs are located in `/var/log/clamav/`

Verify via the `netstat` command that the `clamd` daemon is properly running and the address of the socket (`inet/unix`) on which it binds.

```
root@server:~# netstat -lnp | grep clam
```

Output should be

```
tcp        0      0 127.0.0.1:3310          0.0.0.0:*               LISTEN
25726/clamd
```

or

```
unix 2      [ ACC ]     STREAM    LISTENING   243718 25495/clamd
/var/run/clamav/clamd.sock
```

Check the version

```
root@server:~$ sudo clamdscan -V
ClamAV 0.98.1/19025/Sat May 24 10:04:32 2014
```
