

Boot to text console by default

Just in-case you like the idea of disabling your Ubuntu desktop's graphical interface upon start-up and put you in terminal mode. Open terminal and edit `/etc/default/grub` file

```
sudo vim /etc/default/grub
```

look for this line:

```
GRUB_CMDLINE_LINUX_DEFAULT="quiet splash"
```

change it to:

```
GRUB_CMDLINE_LINUX_DEFAULT="quiet splash text"
```

then update your grub

```
sudo update-grub
```

then restart:

```
sudo reboot now
```

if you want to use the desktop just type: `unity` or `startx`

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
