

# Powershell commands

You can't run unsigned scripts if you don't enable execution of unsigned scripts. Consult with your sysadmin on this as it is essentially a security risk

```
set-executionpolicy unrestricted
```

- Add domain user to local group
- Change AD user password using Powershell
- Create AD OU from powershell
- Create DNS records with PowerShell
- Create X.509 certificate via Powershell
- Download files with powershell
- Managing ActiveDirectory using PowerShell
- Managing Exchange using PowerShell
- NIC Teaming and VLAN tag
- Query all DiskControllers and its associated diskdrives
- Set folder ACL with Powershell
- Setup a Domain Controller with Windows 2016 Server Core
