# Which SharePoint version do I have installed?

There is no easy way to find out what SharePoint 2013 Edition you are running. You can do it by doing one of two things:

- You have to dig the registry
- Use PowerShell

# Registry method

- Open Regedit
- Navigate to HKLM\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Shared Tools\Web Server Extensions\15.0\WSS\InstalledProducts
- Compare the guids with the list

## PowerShell method

- Open SharePoint management Shell
- Type the comment "(Get-SPFarm).Products" (without the quotes)
- Compate the guids with the list
