

Enable RDP from powershell on windows 8/11

To enable remote desktop connections under Windows 8, just start powershell and enter these commands:

Windows 8

```
(Get-WmiObject win32_TerminalServiceSetting -Namespace  
root\\cimv2\\TerminalServices).SetAllowTSConnections(1)  
import-module netsecurity -ea stop ; Get-NetFirewallRule | ?  
{$_.displayname -like \"remote desktop*\"} | Set-NetFirewallRule -  
enabled true
```

Windows 11

```
Set-ItemProperty -Path 'HKLM:\System\CurrentControlSet\Control\Terminal  
Server' -name \"fDenyTSConnections\" -value 0  
Enable-NetFirewallRule -DisplayGroup \"Remote Desktop\"
```

The commands can be ran remotely if you have [SSH](#) server installed - like i did :)
